

2-way vehicular traffic on Exhibition Road flyover soon

Patna: The Exhibition Road flyover will soon be opened for two-way vehicular traffic.



CM Nitish Kumar on Saturday also directed the road construction de-

partment (RCD) officials to connect the GPO-Chiraiyatand flyover with the Exhibition Road flyover, on which vehicles are currently allowed to move only from the Ram Gulam Chowk end.

"There is no reason why vehicles should not ply from both the ends on the Exhibition Road flyover," Nitish told the RCD officials while inspecting the ongoing construction work on the GPO-Chiraiyatand flyover.

The CM, accompanied by state RCD minister Nand Kishore Yadav and chief secretary Anjani Kumar Singh, walked on foot from the GPO flyover to Chiraiyatand flyover and inquired about diffe-

rent aspects of the construction work.

He also asked the officers to make arrangements for free parking of autos and e-rickshaws in the multi-storey parking lot of Buddha Smriti Park in order to reduce vehicular congestion in the Patna Junction area.

The CM later inspected the construction work on the connecting flyover between the GPO and R-Block.

RCD's principal secretary Amrit Lal Meena, CM's principal secretary Chanchal Kumar and Patna DM Sanjay Kumar Agarwal also accompanied the CM during the inspection of flyovers.
