Subject: Setting up and Numbering Kilometer Stones on National Highways as per the new NH numbering scheme-reg.

Please refer to the Gazette Notification S.O. No. 689(E) dated 04-04-2011 vide which the Ministry notified the new National Highway numbers. It has come to the notice of the Ministry that National Highway kilometer stones and 200 m stones are still not indicating the new NH numbers. In case of some of the National Highways Km stones are missing. In many cases, the condition of kilometre stones and 200 m stones is abysmal. Newly declared National Highways are still showing the State Highway numbers.

- 2. Reference is also invited to the Ministry's circular no. RW/NH-33044/27/2004-S&R(R) dated 24-12-2004 regarding the Use of Language on Kilometre Stones and Sign boards on National Highways. It has also come to the notice that the provisions regarding the use of language on Kilometre stones and 200 m stones are not complied at several locations.
- 3. In addition, for procedure and numbering of kilometer stones, Ministry's circular No. RW/NH-33044/10/2002-S&R(R) dated 11-02-2003 and Circular No. RW/NH-33044/27/2004-S&R(R) dated 28-06-2006 may be referred to.
- 4. This situation creates confusion and inconvenience among road-users as well as the public authorities. Therefore, all implementing agencies are requested to follow the Ministry's norms regarding numbering of kilometer stones, the use of language on them and proper installation and complete the updation work within 3 months. Funds required may be met from OR funds. All ROs and ELOs of the Ministry are hereby directed to send a completion report within 120 days from the date of issue of this circular and that the payment may be made to the implementing agencies after the due target is reached.
